Driver's Front Air Bag May Tear

An air bag that does not deploy as intended increases the risk of injury during a crash.

General Motors, LLC (GM) is recalling certain 2024 Cadillac XT5 vehicles. The driver's front air bag cushion may tear during deployment, resulting in the air bag not deploying as intended.

EGR Valve May Short and Cause Loss of Drive Power

A loss of drive power increases the risk of a crash.

Hyundai Motor America (Hyundai) is recalling certain 2024 Elantra, Venue, and Kona vehicles. An electrical short circuit may occur in the exhaust gas recirculation (EGR) valve assembly, which can result in a loss of drive power.

Remedy

A fuel leak may cause an engine stall, increasing the risk of a crash. A fuel leak in the presence of an ignition source can increase the risk of a fire.

Remedy

A high voltage battery with water damage can cause a fire or a vehicle stall, increasing the risk of injury or a crash.

Brake Booster Corrosion May Impair Braking

Reduced brake performance or brake failure can increase the risk of a crash.

Moisture may accumulate and cause corrosion in the brake booster housing unit, which can result in reduced brake performance or brake failure.

Remedy

Owners are advised not to drive their vehicles until the remedy has been performed. Dealers will remove the rubber sleeve, inspect the brake booster, and as necessary, replace the brake booster. All repairs will be

A roof panel that detaches while driving can create a road hazard and increase the risk of a crash.
